

Illness Policy

Children will be visually screened as they arrive. If the child exhibits signs of illness, it will determine if the symptoms indicate the need for exclusion until the child is well. In the event a child becomes ill and needs to be picked up the child will be separated from the rest of the children until the parent or other authorized person arrives. Your child will not be authorized to attend MPN if he/she exhibits any of the following symptoms:

- Fever of 101°F or higher
- Communicable disease
- Diarrhea with three or more watery stools in 24 hours
- Vomiting on two or more occasions during the past 24 hours
- A rash
- Eye discharge or pinkeye
- Lice or nits
- Too ill or tired to participate in normal activities

Your child may return to MPN after he or she is free from signs of illness for 24 hours or with a doctor's authorization to return.

Medications

Written consent is required to administer ANY medication. All prescription medication must be in its original container and properly labeled with the child name. Your pharmacist may be able to provide you with a separate container of medicine that can be left with me. If medication the parents are responsible for signing the Authorization to Administer Prescribed Medication Release and Indemnification Agreement before administering any prescribe medicine.



Non-prescribe medication WILL NOT be administered by any MPN staff.
